ORDER

THIS MATTER came before the Commission on June 23, 2004 and after its earlier decision in docket 548. In apparent reaction to the ruling in Docket 548, various persons in the community expressed their opinion that if DS3 Service was commercially available there would be a substantial demand, sufficient to justify the Commission requiring VITELCO to tariff and provide the service. Being satisfied in the premises, it is

ORDERED that the Public Service Commission staff conduct a survey investigation to ascertain what demand for DS3 service currently exists in the Virgin Islands. Said investigation shall be completed and submitted to the Commission no later than 60 days from the date hereof.
