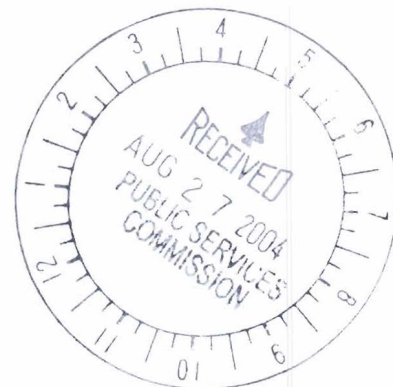

ORDER

The above-captioned matter came on for consideration before the Virgin Islands Public Services Commission ("Commission") on August 25, 2004, for the interim assessment of the expenses of the investigation. Pursuant to a proper motion after review of the staff's report and recommendation, the Commission voted that the Virgin Islands Water and Power Authority be assessed the sum of \$2,000.00 pursuant to the provisions of V.I. Code Ann. *tit. 30, '25*;
